



Zadar is not too crowded, it's not overrun with tourists and its two unique attractions – the sound-

and-light spectacle of the Sea Organ and the Sun Salutation – need to be seen and heard to be believed. Šibenik is located in a deep inlet where the river Krka flows into the Adriatic Sea. Its port is very well protected from all winds and is ideal as a starting point of your cruise. Numerous churches, monasteries, palaces and four fortresses 'frame' the city, and also testify to the perseverance, renunciation and faith of generations of people of Šibenik.

Primošten is located on a peninsula that was an island once and is one of the most attractive destinations on the Adriatic coast with a typical look of an old fishing town.



Recipe Spaghetti with mussels

Ingredients

250 g spaghetti

20-30 mussels

4 pieces of garlic 5 cherry tomatoes

1 dL white wine

Pepper

1 smaller chili pepper

2 spoons olive oil

1 spoon capers

2 dL whey

Boil spaghetti in salted water and dry when boiled. Put mussels in the pot and steam them in closed pot so that they discard their shell. Save the water where you steamed the mussels and put it aside. Put the chopped (or squished) garlic in a frying pan and fry on olive oil for a few moments. Add chopped cherry tomatoes and stir for a minute. Add your white wine, whey and the mussel liquid you've saved before. Put a pinch of milled pepper to spice it up a bit. Add a little chili pepper and capers. You should cook altogether until the liquid reduces when you should add your spaghetti and cook altogether for one more minute. Leave few mussel shells for decoration and before you put your dish on a plate- add mussels. Simple and delicious dish is ready for consuming! Enjoy!

Gnocchi with grancigula crab

Homemade gnocchi with grancigula crab is one of their most sought after dishes, and chef was kind enough to share the recipe! With just a couple ingredients being necessary for this dish, it's perfect to prepare it even on your sailing vacation!

Ingredients

Olive oil Garlic

Crab meat

White wine
Drop of cream

Crab caviar (if available)

So, you'll need olive oil, garlic, crab meat, white wine, drop of cream, crab caviar (if available). First things first, over a medium heat fry the garlic on olive oil. Then, add crab meat and a glass of white wine, the good kind – if it's good enough to drink it, it's good enough to cook with it. When the alcohol evaporates, pour in the cream, add the caviar and stir until the sauce is combined. Cook the gnocchi and add them to the rest of the dish, grate some parmesan cheese over the dish, a bit of freshly ground pepper and a tiny bit of salt! That's it – you have your proper Dalmatian dish ready and served!

Sea bass carpaccio

Given the specific location, part of the menu changes on a daily basis depending on the availability of fresh local produce, while herbs and salt are grown and procured by Moro team themselves. Team leader and chef Marko Ivančević claims that around Moro there is nothing tastier than fresh fish carpaccio so on a there is a special place for fresh sea bass carpaccio with bitter oranges and vegetables.

Ingredients for four people

400 g of fresh sea bass

Bitter oranges emulsion

Cucumber, spring onion and zucchini gazpacho

Pickled kohlrabi

Basil oil

Raspberry powder

Peas microgreens Flower of salt


Cut the fresh sea bass filet on smaller pieces and season it with bitter oranges emulsion and flower of salt, and then chill it in the fridge. After an hour, put it on a plate, together with the gazpacho of cucumbers, spring onions and zucchini, pickled kohlrabi, basil oil and raspberry oil. Some of these ingredients may be difficult to find so you can replace them as follows: instead of bitter orange emulsion use freshly squeezed orange or lemon juice, replace basil oil with extra virgin olive oil, and gazpacho and pickled kohlrabi replace with fruit such as oranges or figs. Season altogether with coarse sea salt.


If you're a light sleeper you must pack earplugs and an eye mask in case the motor starts up early or the sun shines through the porthole.








Interesting facts about Croatia

The island of Cres is home to the last remaining colony of griffon vultures.

- The last specimens of the Mediterranean seal live in the Croatian aquatorium.
- The world famous beach Zlatni rat, located on the island of Brač changes its shape and colour depending on the winds.
- On the island of Susak women wear the shortest folk costumes in Europe having the only national costume that sits above the knee.

Also, to minimize the contact and speed up the takeover, we have prepared a self checkin procedure with video guides. That way, your vacation can start more safely and quickly than ever before!
